

On this 15-year anniversary, I am using this medium to congratulate the entire membership of RCCG Jesus House Huntsville for how God has sustained the church in the past 14 years.




CONGRATULATION JESUS HOUSE HUNTSVILLE





GENESIS 1:27-28

It is in the original plan of God for us to operate on a Higher Ground. God created Man with the authority to dominate but sin took away that dominion. Glory be to God that there is Redemption through Jesus.

Rev. 5: 10, And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.

God created us to be kings and priests to rule on this earth, however the only way to reign is to operate on a higher Ground.

The following point will help you on your journey to Higher Ground.

- **Assess and recognizes where you are (Phil 3. 12 -14)** You must be dissatisfied with your present situation. Have the unquenchable yearning that you can operate on Higher Ground.
- **You must have a hunger and thirst that nothing can quench.** A rugged determination.
- **You must have the tenacity and selfless dedication.**
- **Forget those things that are behind. (Isaiah 43 : 18 - 19)** If you let go of the past you will be able to focus on your present and future goals, see clearer and strategize. (Phil. 3: 13)
- **Our God is a God of Progress and is always doing new things.** (Philippians 4: 13, Deut. 28 : 13)

PRICES FOR HIGHER GROUND

- **Consecration:** You must be set apart and sold out for God. no more personal agenda.
- **Be focused:** Do not allow distractions. Walk with the wise. Fly with the eagles.
- **Continuation:** You must continue to aspire higher everyday. Let Jesus be your ultimate standard. Psalm 1: 1-3 “Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.”
- **Conservation:** You must be willing to keep your Higher Ground status. Alone with God will help you in this regard. Gen. 32 : 24 - 26 “And Jacob was left alone; and there wrestled a man with him until the breaking of the day. And when he saw that he prevailed not against him, he touched the hollow of his thigh; and the hollow of Jacob's thigh was out of joint, as he wrestled with him. And he said, Let me go, for the day breaketh. And he said, I will not let thee go, except thou bless me.”

Jacob was left alone and he wrestled with an angel and would not give up until he prevailed and conquered.



BACK TO BETHEL

Pastor Peter Oyediran

Genesis 35:1

Then God said to Jacob, “Arise, go up to Bethel and dwell there; and make an altar there to God, who appeared to you when you fled from the face of Esau your brother.”

Bethel is a place of encounter with God. The essence of going back to Bethel is to return to that place of your divine encounter with God.

Jacob encountered God at Bethel while running away from the face of his brother Esau.

Genesis 28:10-22

Jacob - after making peace with his brother dwelt at the city of Shechem in Canaan but God instructed him to go back to Bethel where Jacob had a special encounter with God the first time.

In our days, many believers have drifted further away from God. God wants us to get back at the foot of God's ladder of fellowship again. Covenant ourselves to Him and dedicate our lives to His service. Some believers in Christ have backslidden from the faith but God is calling us to come back to a place of fellowship with HIM.

Jacob had left Bethel 30 years when God called him to return back to Bethel. This simply meant Jacob needed to return back to God's presence and rebuild the relationship with God and dwell in His presence.

Psalm 27: 4

One thing have I desired of the Lord, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to enquire in his temple.

WHY DO WE NEED TO GO BACK TO BETHEL?

God wants to take us back to the days long gone by. It seems the Heavenly vision some of us saw when we first gave our lives to Christ have faded away and God is calling us back unto repentance as God begins to lift us from one level of greatness to another, we forgot where God brought us from.

We forgot that He brought us from the Miry clay and set our feet on the Solid rock.

Psalm 40: 2-4

2 He brought me up also out of a horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and established my goings.

3 And he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the Lord.

4 Blessed is that man that maketh the Lord his trust, and respecteth not the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.

Our desire to preach the Gospel, win souls for God and stand tall for God anywhere has started to dwindle and God is saying come back to Bethel - A place of divine encounter with God.

Romans 9:10-13

And not only this, but when Rebecca also had conceived by one man, even by our father Isaac (for the children not yet being born, nor having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works but of Him who calls), it was said to her, "The older shall serve the younger." As it is written, "Jacob I have loved, but Esau I have hated."

This month the Mercy of God will speak for you in Jesus name

God will use mercy to solve your problems

Mercy is the platform that allows favour to flow towards a person or a thing.

What is Mercy?

Compassion or forgiveness shown towards someone when it is within one's power to punish or harm

The word mercy is from the latin word "merced or merces" which means "price paid"

Jesus paid the price for our sins Col 1:14

-An act of kindness, compassion or favour
Act 20:28

Mercy - is the nature and attitude of God.

Mercy - is the patience of God.

Speak to utter words or articulate sounds.

- The ordinary voice.
- To communicate vocally
- To deliver an address

Mercy is the cancellation of the ugly past.

God's Mercy

It is compassion and the kindness that is shown on the offender that deserves judgement and his punishment is cancelled through forgiveness.

- Mercy is when God stoops low as the superior to serve man who is inferior. Heb 4:14-16
- Mercy is when God set aside judgement to let His love for you prevail
- Mercy is when your failure does not count. As new chapters of favour are opened.
- Mercy is when the voice of compassion speaks louder than that of judgement.
- Mercy is the major requirement in the school of divine assistance and double/durable wonders. Titus 3:5.

Mercy can speak

James 2:13; Mercy rejoiceth against judgement. Matt 5:7. It makes others to be merciful unto you.

- When mercy is at work

How mercy speaks.

1. Mercy can speak healing: Mathew 9:27-30. Their blind eyes were opened.
2. Mercy can speak of fruitfulness- turning delay barrenness into fruitfulness. Luke 1:58, Isaiah 1:10-19.
3. Mercy can speak deliverance- Canaanite woman: Mathew 15:21-28.
4. Mercy can speak hope where there is no hope- 1 kings 17:8
5. Mercy can speak salvation- John 8:1-10, Luke 1:54-55. The widow of saraphat.
6. Mercy rejoice before judgement- James 2:13

What happens when mercy speaks.

1. Impossibility becomes possible-Matt 17:14-21, Mark 9:22-23
2. There will be deliverance- protocol Matt 15:21-28, the Canaanite woman
3. There will be healing: mark 10:51-52, Luke 17:11-19 Lord have mercy in/ heal me
4. You enjoy what you do not deserve or qualify for. Matt 15:21-28
John 8, Romans 8:15-16. The children's food was given to her.
- The most disadvantaged become repositioned into the most advantageous estate-prison to palace.
5. Heaven will stand still for you. Mark 10:49-51- divine attention

6. Protocols are broken for your sake.
The food that was not intended for her was given to her. Matt 15:26-27

7. Barrenness will be terminated: Elizabeth-Luke 1:58, 1 Sam 1:9-19. Mercy blessed the effort.

8. You enjoy divine preferential treatment. Jacob was prefered than Eassu.
Rom 9:10-13, Daniel prefered to saul 2 sam 7:15-16

9. Speedy answers to prayers-Mark 10:46- Difficult requests are answered; Moses Exo 33:18-23

10. Divine exception from judgement: Lk 23:39-43. John 8:1-11. Lot Gen 19:19
Woman caught in adultery
The thief on the cross
The woman was condemned to death but mercy says no: the devil wants to destroy your destiny but mercy says no.

11. Enjoy divine favor- Gen 39:21
May mercy locate you/speak for you today.

How to provoke the mercy of God.

1. Be merciful unto others- Matt 5:7
2. Mercy works at the instance of faith. Mark 10:52, Matt 9:27-31. 2 blind men, when mercy is speaking nothing is impossible, it can still be well for you inside the well-daniel/Joseph
3. You need to humble yourself- It take humility to cry for help Luke 18:13
4. You need to cry for mercy- A closed mouth is a closed destiny mark 10
5. You must be redeemed by the blood of jesus: Blood of Jesus cry for mercy. Heb 12:24
6. Confess your sins: Pro 28:13
Conclusion: it is only by mercy you can receive anything from God that can become anything, that you are alive today: to get to heaven you need mercy.

Prayer Points.

1. God of 11th hour miracle let mercy speak for me this day in jesus name.
2. Father please by mercy solve my problems today and answer my prayers today in jesus name.
3. Father let mercy break protocol for me today and give unto me what i don't qualify for or deserves in Jesus name.
4. Father let mercy speak healing to my body today in Jesus name.
5. Father let mercy do the impossible in my life today in Jesus name.
6. Father let mercy promote me in Jesus name even position i do not qualify for.
7. Father let mercy terminate every delay in my life and turn my barrenness into fruitfulness in Jesus name.
8. Father by your mercy cancel every appointment of death upon my life in Jesus name.
9. Father by mercy recuse my soul and destiny from the coven of witches /wizards in Jesus name
10. Father today where my faith cannot get to, let mercy speak for me in Jesus name.

And he cut down a stick, and cast it in thither; and the iron did swim. Therefore said he, Take it up to thee. And he put out his hand, and took it.

It is high time that believers retrieve back their lost Axe Head that has entered into deep Rivers.

- Your Axe Head is the weapon with which you engage in battle. Jeremiah 51:20-21
- Your axe Head is also the gift inside of you which is particularly unique to you. Isaiah 32:15
- Your axe Head is your power for service. Luke 24: 29

WHERE DID IT FALL?

You must be conscious of the loss of the Axe Head.


OFFENSE AND STRIFE.

11 Now it happened as He went to Jerusalem that He passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. 12 Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off. 13 And they lifted up their voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!"

This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him. John 11 : 40 Jesus saith unto her, Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the glory of God?
- The only antidote to darkness, shame and wickedness in our world today is the manifestation of God's Glory. Isaiah 60 : 1-3 "Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee. And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising."

THE 5 LOVE LANGUAGES OF CHILDREN

You've probably heard of the five love languages: physical touch, gifts, words of affirmation, acts of service, and quality time. The concept was created by Gary Chapman, Ph.D., a marriage counselor known for his best-selling book *The 5 Love Languages*. Dr. Chapman's theory is that we all express and experience love in the same five ways, but everyone—including children—has one specific way that matters most to them.

What Are The Five Love Languages And How To Spot Them?
As explained by Dr. Chapman in his book, children receive and show love in five ways:

1. Quality time
2. Words of affirmation
3. Physical touch
4. Acts of service
5. Receiving gifts

The Five Love Languages of Children

Whether you are struggling to cope with a sudden attitude change in your child or your second baby has flipped your parenting philosophy right out the window, you can benefit from understanding and identifying the five love languages.

1. Words of Affirmation: Don't Skimp On The "I Love You's"

Children who speak this love language really pay attention to your words as they hold a lot of meaning for them. If your praise and verbal declarations of love have your child beaming, their love language is words of affirmation. Such children often shower you with loving words too.

To show love to such a child, you can:

- Get down to their level and tell them you love them.
- Make sure they listen to you, praising them to other people.
- Occasionally put note cards in the lunch box (handwritten work too).
- Appreciate their efforts, "you did so well!"
- Call them by an affectionate name.

Remember that while insults will bring down any child, they can genuinely cut deep for a child that wants to hear your loving words. Thus, it is essential to let them know you love them unconditionally.


Thinking before you speak to your children and HOW you speak to them is vital. Regulate your tone and always choose to reply empathetically.

2. Physical Touch: Shower Them With Kisses and Cuddles

If your child leaps on you as soon as you get home or if they keep touching you, it is a sign that they crave physical touch. For such children, an "I love you" with a hug or small hand squeeze is much more potent than just a verbal declaration.

To show love to such a child, you can:

- Snuggle with them on the couch during movie night.
- Cuddle with them before sleep or as you read to them.



- Hug and kiss them often.
- Give high-fives and
- Give high-fives and squeeze hands as a gesture of love.
- Playfully wrestle with them or call for family hugs.

Remember a slap or spanking is hurtful to any child, but it is devastating to one whose primary love language is touch. Research has also shown that dads tend to become less physically affectionate when their daughters start to grow older because they feel ill at ease, says Dr. Markham. She suggests making a habit of good-morning and good-night hugs, even as kids get older.

3. Quality Time: Prioritize One-on-One Bonding

If your child constantly asks you to play with them, listen to them, or even show you different things, their love language is probably quality time. Such children feel most valued when their parents give them undivided attention, even for a small allotted "special" portion of the day.

It is not so much about WHAT you do but HOW you spend this bonding time. Even small gestures such as stopping to pay attention to your child when they walk into a room can reassure them that their company is valued.

To show love to such a child, you can:

- Let them choose the activity for a daily fun one-on-one session.
- Have meals together.
- Have a heart-to-heart conversion before bed.
- Take them along to run errands.
- Play with them or go for walks.

Remember never to isolate such a child to discipline them as they are much more sensitive to feeling abandoned and will consider this an extreme punishment.

4. Gifts: Use Presents As Tokens of Love

Children who tend to hold onto things even when they do not use them or remember who gave them what as a present for a long time equate receiving gifts to feeling loved. Keep in mind that these gifts are not just things for them to own but an extension and expression of your love. So while your children may appreciate the occasional splurging, they will love small personalized gifts just as much. From cards to photo books to even giving flowers from your jog, such kids view gifts as your way of valuing them. But remember not to go overboard and always give age-appropriate items.

To show love to such a child, you can:

- Get a gift you can work on/ play with together.
- Choose thoughtful gifts they will be interested in.
- Give them stars and stickers for every small milestone.
- Gift them a photo book celebrating your time together.
- Allot a special place to display their gifts.

However, do not use gifts instead of other love languages, or they will lose their value as a token of love.

5. Acts of Service: Fulfill Special Requests

Perhaps the most challenging love language to master is that of acts of service. Children who speak this love language tend to find self-assurance and security in having their parents help with all kinds of things, from getting their clothes on to fixing a toy. Instead of thinking of it as picking up after your child constantly, view acts of service as a way to make them feel extra loved.

- To show love to such a child, you can:
- Tuck them into bed.
- Make their favorite meal.
- Help them organize their room.
- Support them while doing homework.
- Occasionally make an exception to do a chore for them.

While you cannot keep saying yes to every request, weighing your response even when denying your kid is crucial. Although teaching kids independence is crucial to their growth and confidence, instead of turning down their requests completely, you should walk them through various steps of getting the task done and providing support where needed.

WHAT IS GODLY PARENTING

According to the Cambridge Dictionary, parenting can be described as the raising of children and all the responsibilities and activities that are involved in it. This includes providing physical, financial, emotional, social, and spiritual support for the child from infancy to adulthood.



In biblical terms, it is a divine assignment with clear expectations to train your child in the way of the Lord. (Prov 22:6, Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it). It is also a role that comes with accountability.



CHARACTERISTICS OF GODLY PARENTING

SELF-DISCIPLINE

Always remember that you are a mirror to your children. It is therefore important to be a godly example that is worthy of emulation by your children. Lois and Eunice (2 Tim. 1:5) demonstrated godly behaviors which were reflected in the life of Timothy. You can choose to be a model of godliness rather than worldliness and Christlikeness as opposed to self-centeredness. (Colossians 3:23-24, And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ).

ABILITY TO GROW IN THE LORD

Submit yourself to the Holy Spirit who can teach you all things. You don't have to be a Pastor, Teacher, or Deacon/Deaconess to receive the teaching of the Holy Spirit. You need to draw wisdom and strength from the Holy Spirit daily to make godly decisions that will impact the lives of your children in positive ways. Children are distinct from one another, even identical twins, and the Holy Spirit can guide you to discover the blueprint of every child. (John 14:26, But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you).

ALWAYS PRAY OVER THE CHILDREN

Pray over the children without ceasing, even when things are going well or not as expected. We always hope for the best for our children, but sometimes things might not be exactly the way we expect. Never give up on your children, keep praying, and be expectant that God can turn every situation around. In the parable of the prodigal son, the fatted calf is a symbol of festive celebration and rejoicing for someone's long-awaited return which means his father did not give up on him and was hoping that one day, he would come back home (Luke 15: 23-24, And bring hither the fatted calf, and kill it; and let us eat, and be merry: For this my son was dead, and is alive again; he was lost, and is found. And they began to be merry).

DISCIPLINE

This is the responsibility of both parents (Prov. 1:8, My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother). This should be done with love and understanding. Children are not only exposed to the teaching of their parents but are also influenced by other forces. Discipline will help the children to understand the role of authority and know the difference between right and wrong as well as the consequences of bad behavior. For discipline to be effective, it should be applied with wisdom so that it will not lead to rebellious acts from the child.

ACKNOWLEDGE GOOD BEHAVIOR

Always praise your children and reward good behaviors when necessary. If the only thing you are pointing out to your children is bad behaviors, it might have a negative impact on their lives thinking they are good for nothing. Speak and confess positively into their lives.

SPEND QUALITY TIME WITH THE CHILDREN

Another character in the story of the prodigal son was his elder brother who lacked understanding about repentance, confessions, forgiveness, and the grace of God. His father spent quality time with him when he angrily refused the invitation to be part of the celebration in honor of his brother who was lost. If you don't spend time with your children, it might be difficult to identify areas of weakness that need to be addressed in a timely manner.

BE SUPPORTIVE

Provide help with schoolwork and other educational activities. The teenage years can be very challenging considering the role of society in the lives of children. Take time to understand the challenges they are going through and provide necessary guidance and support.

Teach them how to make the correct biblical decisions even if others are doing otherwise (Phil. 4:88 Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things).

In conclusion, shower your children with unconditional love without discrimination. Marital conflict might be inevitable, don't drag your children into it. Allow the peace of God to rule and reign in your home.

WHO is YOUR GUY

If you read that title and thought of a secular song first, immediately visit Pastor Peter for prayers. Jokes aside though, take a moment to ponder on who you can refer to as your guy(s). You can even make a list. Once you're done, you can continue reading. In this article, you'll walk through a list of things to look out for in your guy(s). Afterward, refer to the list you made and see how many people you put on that list and check all the boxes.

Now, you might be wondering who should go on that list. Your guy is one who can influence your decisions as a result of their words or lifestyle; this person is able to speak into your life. This is the person you find yourself around often and believe that they'd have your back. It is very important who you choose as your guy as it could make or break your life. In Proverbs 13:20, the bible says

"Walk with the wise and become wise; associate with fools and get in trouble." Here are seven expectations you should have for the person you regard as your guy:

Your guy is wise: Just like the bible verse above tells us, you will be wise if you associate yourself with wise people. This does not mean to simply be street-smart. While common sense is valuable, the book of Proverbs emphasizes the need for wisdom. This is one truth we know, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom". No matter how intellectual your friends are, you are in trouble if they lack the fear of the Lord.

Your guy has your back: Don't believe me, ask Jonathan and David. We see in the lives of these two what the bible means by a true

friend is born for a time of adversity. The friendship of Jonathan and David is a perfect example of how friends respond during troubled times. If your guy dips when the water is stirred and only returns when all is calm, you need to watch out.

Your guy is willing to sacrifice: The friends Jonathan and David are not just unique because Jonathan protected David when the former's father tried to kill the latter (bible gossip 😅). We often ignore the fact that David was taking away from Jonathan what should have been his according to human standards. Imagine being a prince and helping a commoner who you know would take the throne after your father. Be real! Many would count it as foolishness. However, that's just who your guy should be to you and vice versa.





Your guy speaks the truth: A true friend is willing to call and correct one's mistakes in love. Friends who support wrongdoings are guiding one down the path of destruction. Mordecai was Esther's guy for sure. After guiding her to a point of honor, he did not hesitate to remind her that her silence over Haman's proclamation was wrong. He straight up said if you don't do right, the Lord will provide another option. That should be the expectation we have for the people in our circle. After all, the bible mentioned in Proverbs 27: 9, "the sweetness of a friend's counsel that comes from the heart" makes the heart of the recipient glad.

Your guy intercedes: We have been commanded to pray for all. So, it should not be a new thing for "your person" to pray on your behalf, especially when you are not present. Abraham was in Lot's corner and we see how he pleaded that Sodom would not be destroyed.

their heavenly Father, stick to them closer than a brother. When you find the ones who take your name before their heavenly

Your guy gives you your flowers: The bible that says to let another praise you still stands true. Strangers are able to offer praise when they see the glory in one's life. However, there's a joy that comes from having a friend who can be your hypeman. We are called to encourage one another in 1 Thessalonians 5:11. This should be done on a regular basis. Your guy should give you the flowers you deserve without asking for them. Of course, physical flowers are included too.



Your guy is hardworking: Two is better than one when they both labor. There is value in hard work; it is imperative all members of the friendship remember this. Surround yourself with diligent people. This in itself is a form of motivation; even science agrees. The concept of body doubling shows that people work better when there is a supportive presence.

If you want to improve your work ethic, surround yourself with people who have a great work ethic.

At the end of the day, the ultimate guy is Jesus. Can you say Jesus is my guy with complete confidence? If you can, that's awesome. If not, please see your church leaders or spiritual mentors for counseling and prayers. Also, can Jesus say the same about you? Think about it!!!

It is in the place of total and complete obedience that covenants and promises are fulfilled.

6. Discipleship.

2 Timothy 2: 1:2

The process of discipleship is to continue in an endless chain of disciple-making

7. Total surrender.

Romans 12: 1-2

Hmmm... my mentor says and I quote: "The heart of a matter is the matter of the heart."

8. A contrite heart. (A heart of repentance)

Psalm 119: 47-48

Sin only shows that the flesh has taken the front wheel of someone's life. The moment you allow the spirit to take charge, sin will be under your feet. No matter how many times you fall short of God's glory, repentance from sin (not allowing the same kind of sin to conquer you) is all you need to restore your connection with God.

9. A grateful heart (Thanksgiving as your lifestyle)

1 Kings 8: 63

Thanksgiving is the basic unit of our communication with God. It is the most repeated expression of faith between man and God. Thanksgiving is important because it is a sure sign that a person has a true and vital relationship with God. The faithful are called to give thanks to God for everything and not only to be thankful but to rejoice

Psalm 95: 2

Giving thanks at all times:

When you are happy, be thankful.

When you are sad, be thankful.

When you need or want God to bless you, be thankful.

When you are blessed, be thankful.

When you are sick, be thankful.

When you are healthy, be thankful.

Never stop giving thanks because it is only the living who can give thanks.

10. A forgiving heart

Jesus forgave the Romans who nailed him to the cross. He even forgave every chief priest, elder, and crowd member shouting for his death while placing its responsibility on their heads. Jesus forgave them, which means they were not held guilty for his death.

He also forgave people who did not know they were doing something wrong. He asked Heavenly Father to forgive the men who crucified Him. They didn't know they were hurting the Son of God. Jesus forgives people because He loves them. He actually prayed for Peter whom He knew was going to deny Him.

11. A bold heart.

Case study: 3 Hebrew men

Daniel 3: 16. I have not seen anyone who boldly stood up for God and was disappointed nor forsaken. God always comes through for such a person. He comes to rescue at the right time that will compel those doubting or denying Him to surrender to His leading. He shows up when the testimony will be undeniable and of a must, all glory must be ascribed to Him alone.

Daniel 3: 9-20. If you do not stand for something, you will fall for anything. Be bold standing for God.

12. A humble heart.

Proverbs 29: 23 TPT

Proverbs 15:33 AMP

Esther 8: 1-8 Has God elevated you to a position but you think it is merely for your pleasure? No. God does not work that way because He is always mindful of His children and will strategically position His loved ones to be the armor bearer for those who are in need for such a time as this present time that you are in. Esther 4: 13-16

There are 4 ways by which people portray humility:

Natural humility: these are people who are naturally humble and they don't have to force it. If you belong to this category, be thankful and work on other areas that need improvements.

Contrived humility: people who fake humility fall into this category. Either to manipulate others or for some selfish reasons, they are humble towards others. This disingenuous strategy is usually short-lived and obvious to all, causing even more damage than unapologetic arrogance. If you belong to this category, it is better you stop it and ask God for grace for a humble heart.

Humbled humility: this category of people has been humbled by poison or situations of life. Not that they necessarily want to be humble but they have been faced with issues and challenges of life that have compelled them to be humble. If you belong to this category, I pray for God to intervene and give you the grace to be humble indeed not because you are pained.

Intentional humility: if you truly desire to become a more humble person in spite of your natural tendencies then here is the category where you belong to. It is owning who you are, and putting specific strategies in place to behave more humbly. This does not come naturally so you have to ask God for the grace and He will impart you with it.

There are those who are not humble at all. They have allowed pride to overshadow them and that will only end in disaster. No one, most importantly no child of God should find Humility paves the way and brings about favor.

There is grace and more grace for being humble. James 4: 6 TPT

13. A willing heart.

Luke 1: 26-35, Luke 1: 38 MSG

Mary was ready to serve in any capacity as long as it pleased The Lord. She was available and usable. She was fit for The Master's use! 2 Timothy 2: 19-22

14. Sacrificial heart

Mark 14: 3-9 Have you ever imagined saving all that you earn in a year without touching a cent out of it and then you gather it all and bring it as an offering unto The Lord?

That was exactly what Mary did. She did not withhold anything from Jesus, she went as far as breaking the jar of oil which means nothing will be left of it. Furthermore, she used her hair to wipe Jesus's feet. If this act of Mary is not sacrificial, I do not know what is.

LEGALLY

CAVEAT EMPTOR- LET THE BUYER BEWARE



In my 15 years of practice in Nigeria, one of the most interesting observations with the public, especially individuals or small business owners is to avoid the lawyer until there is a problem that is much bigger than what it would have costed to retain legal advisory from the onset. Majority of clients only come in after the fact or when they have been sued and require a lawyer to represent them in the lawsuit. Having crossed to the United States, even I am amazed at the level of legality that go into every single aspect of the society and every transaction. Coming from a jurisdiction where the law is either non-existent, obsolete, unenforced or frustrated by sheer lawlessness, injustice, poverty and a weak criminal justice system and civil climate, it is great to know that the law works here in the United States and to a large extent are enforceable and reliable. The rule of law and equality before the law works. Unfortunately, it can become a bad thing where you become victims of legality and the same law works against you, either due to ignorance, disregard or inputting old ways from your experience in other places into the new culture.

An individual becomes victim of legality when Inadequate or no understanding of the legal terms and implications Lost rights, privileges or inadvertent liabilities unfair but acceptable practices particularly in trade and commerce, among others. Immigrations, Consumer Loans and Real Estates are three major areas where immigrants experience the most bout with legality. It is interesting that both old and established immigrants continue to fall into pitfalls of legality and pay dearly- sometimes even without knowing because a lot is buried in the books. Our accent (No matter how hard we try to change it mostly gives us away), Credit Score (Which shows no significant history commensurate to age and status) and uncommon names are quick give aways that many players in these sectors have used to identify and sometimes deal with the unwary consumer/ client who are immigrants and may be totally or partially aware of the rights, privileges, pitfalls and connotations of certain terms that have established usages. Here are a few Scenarios:

Scenario 1

Immigrations

Cecilia was introduced to a lawyer in Chicago, she provided details and agreed to a total of \$12,000 fee upon completion of her immigration process. At the end of 5 years, several disappointments and \$27,000 due to unforeseen appeals gone. She realized that the assurances from her lawyer was not enforceable as he was only required to do his best under the law and he was entitled to his fee, regardless of the outcomes of the matter. She later heard that Lawyer Ben was a good real estate lawyer, but he had just ventured into Immigrations Law to diversify his law practice and mainly outsourced the immigrations cases to his junior lawyers who have very little experience or understanding of immigrations.

Scenario 2

Consumer Loans

Soji bought a set of furniture from a Furniture Store. The Store had advertised a 0% interest. He was new in town and he was just building his credit, even though he was 32 years old. He had come from a country that had no Credit Score system and this was all new to him. It was even more exciting that unlike his home country, here in America, he could get the furnishing he needed for his new apartment and offset the payment over time, with the 0%. Soji was approved for \$2500 which he went ahead and picked some simple furniture with the hope to pay up and be debt-free soon. He paid the first 3 months on time and was quite happy with his progress. In the 4th month of his loan, his balance came

back and he now owed \$4,671.89. He thought it was a typographical error, but no it was not. The 0% had elapsed in 3 months and the interest had ballooned by such staggering percentage that he would take forever to payback. He called and emailed, and realized that the information was buried somewhere in a document he signed. He has to deal with it, because he had signed it with the condition.

Scenario 3

Real Estates Mike

was excited about buying his new home, he had a good job, been around for some years and he was very frugal about his expenses. His bank and financial institutions flooded his mailbox and inbox with all sorts of offers. He and his wife had gotten ready to buy their new home and they were checking on google and different sites to see the home of their dream. Realtors in their city soon found them and they were quite excited by the abundance of offers and perks that each offered them. Mike's wife had been a lawyer in Nigeria and had done a number of Real Estate transactions, they agreed not to retain a Realtor- they believed they would instead bargain with the seller and get some discounts off their purchase. They closed on a freshly upgraded 4- Bedroom FSBO and were quite impressed with the willingness of the seller to give generous discounts. It has been 2 years and several repairs and work done. The savings was long gone and an attempt to annul the sale has been impossible. The 22 year old structure was falling apart and so was their joy.

These three scenarios can be addressed under the principle of Let the Buyer Beware (Caveat Emptor); In Nigeria, it is simply called "Shine your eye". It is a fundamental principle in most contractual and commercial transaction that places the burden of due diligence on the buyer of a good or service even when you are dealing with professionals. Caveat Emptor requires the buyer to be responsible for ensuring suitability, non-defect, compliance or any other satisfaction and standards that the buyer would expect to receive and enjoy from the particular purchase. Due to the potential for sellers to have more experience than the buyer about the transaction, there is always a chance that the buyer would not be able to provide the needful due diligence, which invariably puts the buyer in a position detrimental but yet legal and acceptable to the advantage of the seller.

As much as is within the power of a buyer, get professional or legal assistance especially with big ticket purchases and expenses and be sure to take time to read through documents before you sign- ask questions and ensure that you get clarifications on the immediate, mid term and long term concerns- financially and otherwise. Let The Buyer Beware that the smiles, kind gestures and customer service is primarily for the benefit of the business owners- do not get carried away to avoid costly consequences.

When next you sign or deal in any document or commitments that have legal implications, remember, emotion or ignorance will cost you dearly. Shine your eye and let the buyer beware. Always!


As we go into the 15th year, what is one moment you can think of and say God is faithful?
