CHURCH ADMINISTRATION

The two main priority areas that should be focused on by the Church Administrator include: protection and provision.

Protection:

In your teaching show integrity, seriousness and soundness of speech that cannot be condemned, so that those who oppose you may be ashamed because they have nothing bad to say about us" (Titus 2:7-8, NIV). The well-being and security of the Pastor and his family should never be neglected, this we can achieve through praying and supporting them. Our Pastor needs to live comfortably in the neighborhood where he is serving and the church is charged with this responsibility. "The elders who direct the affairs of the church well are worthy of double honor, especially those whose work is preaching and teaching" (1 Timothy 5:17, NIV). Our children are the future leaders of our community and nation and should be taught the word of God rightly. "Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it" (Proverbs 22:6, NKJV). The Administrator needs to screen the children's workers before they are approved to be part of the Children Department. This will enable teachers having the fundamental understanding of the gospel to impact the same into the lives of our children. Weekly conversation with the HOD of the Children's Department in areas of needs and challenges should be encouraged, with occasional visits to the children during their worship services.



Provision:

This is preparing before a need arises in Church. The Church Administrator should always plan for future needs, and store up for inevitable period of shortage. He needs to be focused as he assumes the role of a long-term strategist, apart from attending to the church's short-term needs. Effective planning is very important, because this prevents mistakes being made. "The plans of the diligent lead to profit, as surely as haste leads to poverty" (Proverbs 21:5, NIV).

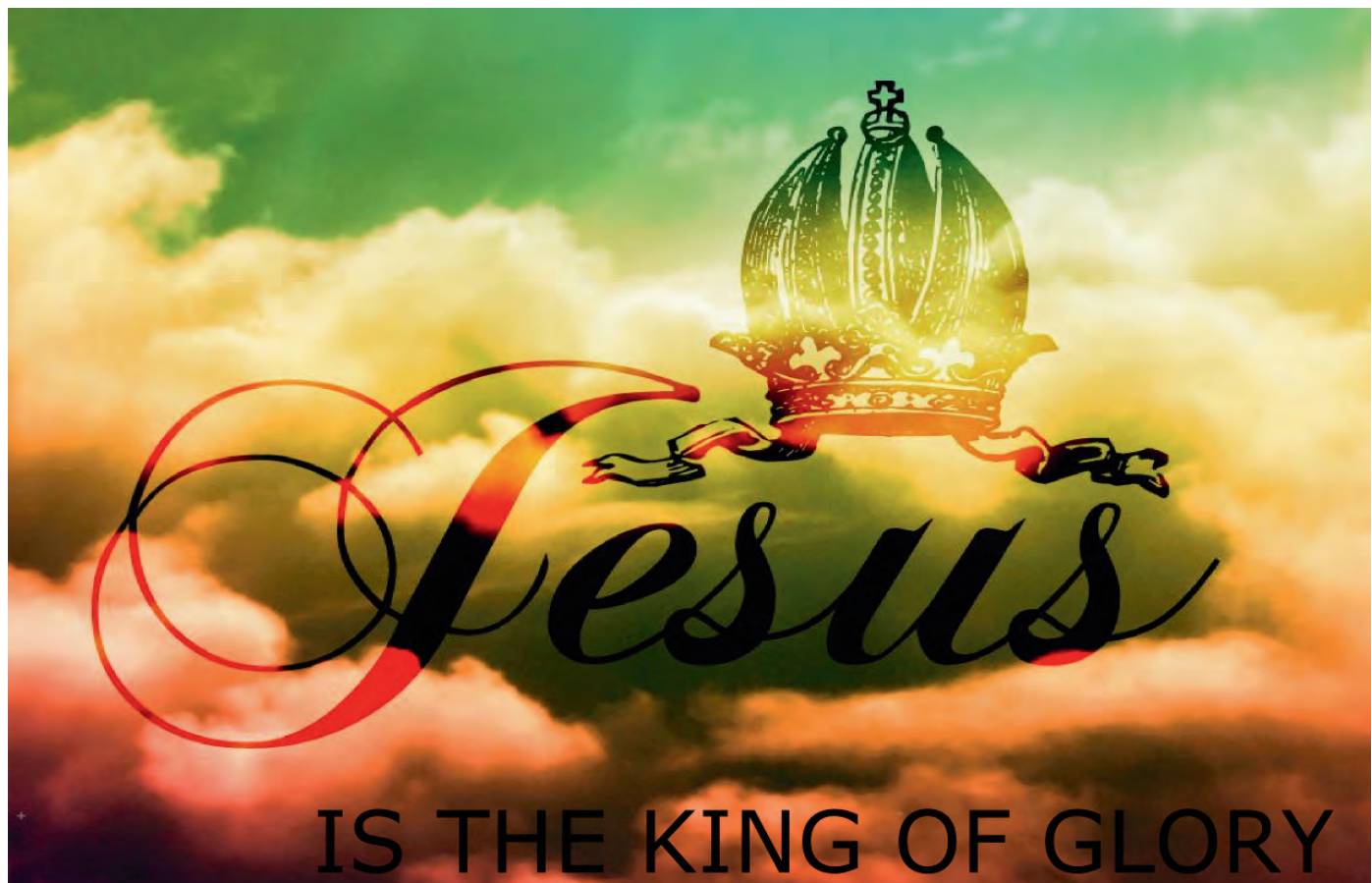

IT IS WELL WITH YOU

INTERVIEW WITH PASTOR PETER OYEDIRAN

Can you briefly tell us about your ministerial background and spiritual mentorship?

My name is Pastor Peter Oyediran. I was born and raised in a Christian home. My father was a Priest/ Catechist in Anglican Church. He instilled in me the passion to work for God right from my childhood days. I became a born-again Christian in September 15, 1989 as a freshman in School of Nursing during a welcome program organized by Fellowship of Christian Nurses. I experienced rapid spiritual growth and later served as the General Secretary of the Fellowship for two years. After my graduation, I joined RCCG where I participated in various training programs, Ministers' Conferences, Annual Conventions among others. I was initially ordained as a Deacon and later as a Pastor by God's grace. My ministerial tutelage has been majorly through the teachings of Pastor E.A. Adeboye who is my role model and spiritual mentor to date.

Succinctly enumerate some remarkable growth and breakthroughs experienced since the last church anniversary.

God has been so good to us this passing year. Members testified of the Lord's goodness in the areas of fruits of the womb, safe deliveries, healings, deliverances, immigration breakthroughs, admission/graduation from colleges among others. Frankly speaking, it is difficult for me to single out a program as the most memorable because every program had its unique grace, purpose and anointing, and thus met the specific needs of the church members. Personally, all the programs have been impactful and effective. We thank God for His divine backing and financial provision in supporting these programs.

As the Pastor of RCCG JHH for the past years, what are your major challenges and how have you overcome most, if not all, of them?

God allows challenges to come our ways in order to groom, shape and develop us in trusting Him for solutions. Firstly, I am always bothered by the lackadaisical attitude of some members towards the work of God, though there has been some progress in this regard through spiritual enlightenment programs. Our major challenge has been in the area of acquisition of church building. We are making some moves towards this goal and we are still trusting God for financial blessings in order to actualize this lofty project in no distant time.

Under your leadership, can you describe some notable ways the church has positively impacted her immediate community and beyond in the past years?

Our goal is to build a church without walls by reaching to people all over the globe through various technological means such as social networking, public outreach activities, and broadcasting of church programs on local TV stations like FOX 54, my8 etc. The church held some social events such as annual summer picnics aimed at reaching out to new people. Recently we organized yard sales through which some new items were sold to members of the general public at give-away prices. Some church groups visited and donated generously to the less-privileged/homeless people in our immediate community among others.

BY THIS TIME NEXT YEAR

"Then the LORD said, I will surely return to you about this time next year, and Sarah your wife will have a son" (Genesis 18:10 NIV).

Wonders never end! Sarah and Abraham seemed to say when God told them that they would have their own child "about this time next year" (Genesis 17:15-16, 19-21; 18:10, 13-14). How would a hundred-year old man impregnate a ninety-year woman? Naturally speaking, this is impossible. Sarah laughed it off, while Abraham gave God another option to fulfil His promise concerning him through other means (Genesis 17:18). However, God insisted that His promise of making Abraham the father of many nations would be fulfilled through the son that Sarah would bear to him, "for nothing is impossible with God" (Luke 1:37 NIV, Genesis 18:14; Jeremiah 32:17, 27; Mark 10:27; Luke 18:27).

God did fulfil His promise. In Genesis 21:1-2, the Bible says, "Now the LORD was gracious to Sarah as he had said, and the LORD did for Sarah what he had promised. Sarah became pregnant and bore a son to Abraham in his old age, at the very time God had promised him". I want to emphasize two salient points from this passage:

- (i) The unmerited favour of God upon Sarah made God to remember her and fulfil His promise in her life.
- (ii) God fulfilled His promise for Abraham and Sarah at the very appointed time.

What are you also trusting God to do for you? Have you lost hope on it? By this time next year, God would have done that thing for you in His own way, and at His very appointed time. God will be gracious to you and remember you for good in Jesus name. It may not even be up to a year. It may be less than a year, a month, a week, or even a day. Remember, the Lord spoke through Prophet Elisha, "Hear the word of the LORD. This is what the LORD says: about this time tomorrow, a measure of flour will sell for a shekel and two measures of barley for a shekel at the gate of Samaria" (2 Kings 7:1 NIV). The prophecy did happen less than a day. The officer who did not believe only saw it but never enjoyed it.

By this time next year, you also will have one or more things to testify about God's goodness in your life in Jesus name. Amen.

In today's world of uncertainties, conflicts and economic crises, what is your candid advice to the end-time believers?

The Bible says "the just shall live by his faith" (Habakkuk 2:4b). I therefore admonish all end-time believers to have unwavering faith in God, meditate more on his words, pray constantly and cling unto God for their sustenance and survival in this turbulent time.

Any final words for everyone?

The Bible says "repent ye, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand" (Matthew 3:2). Let us remember that Jesus Christ is coming very soon for a church without spot or wrinkle. Therefore holiness, humility and total surrenderedness should be our watchword. A day is coming when we will all give accounts of our stewardship to God. My heartfelt prayer is that God will sustain all believers to the end and more perishing souls will be saved through our evangelistic efforts in Jesus name. Shalom!

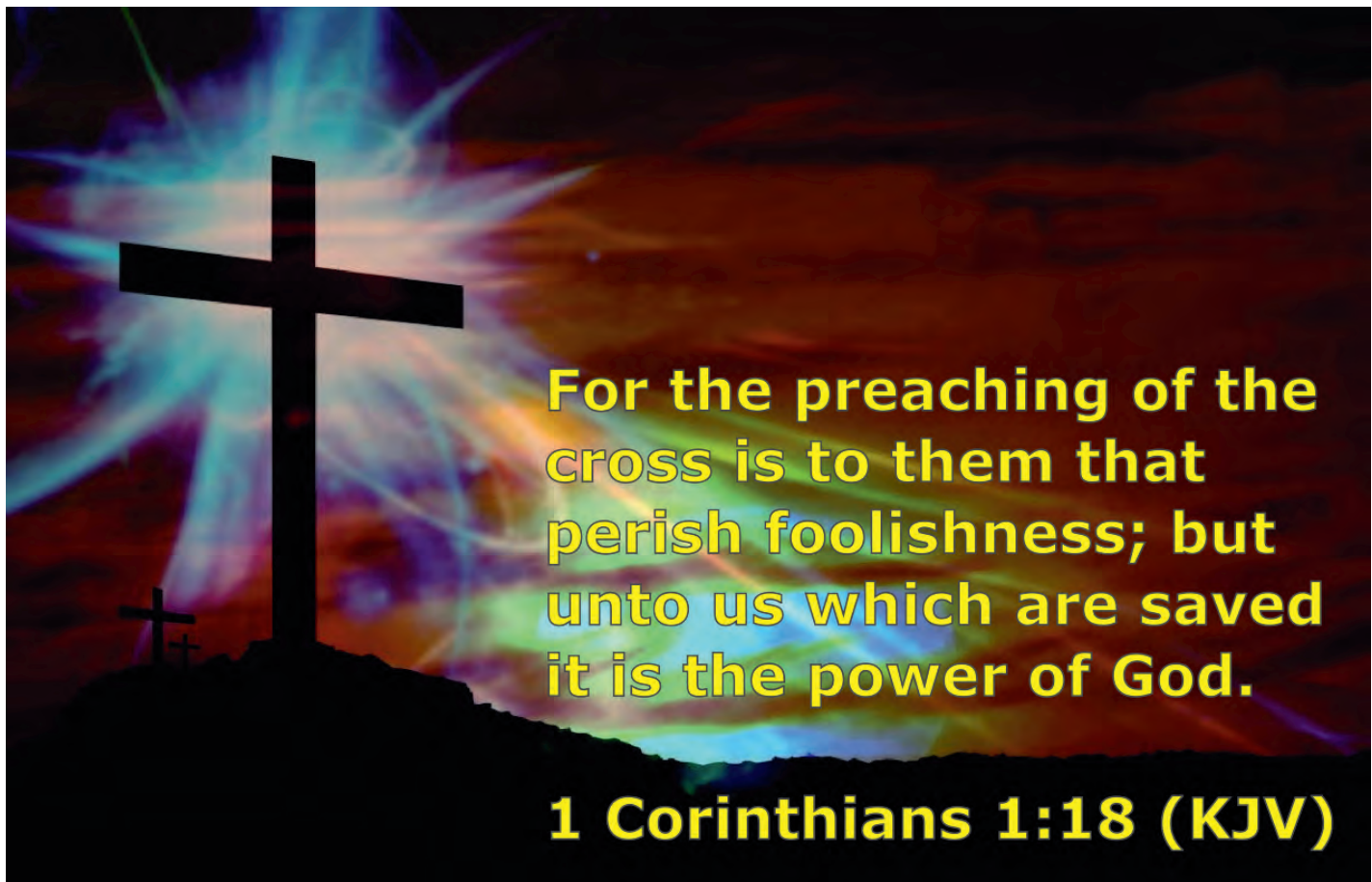

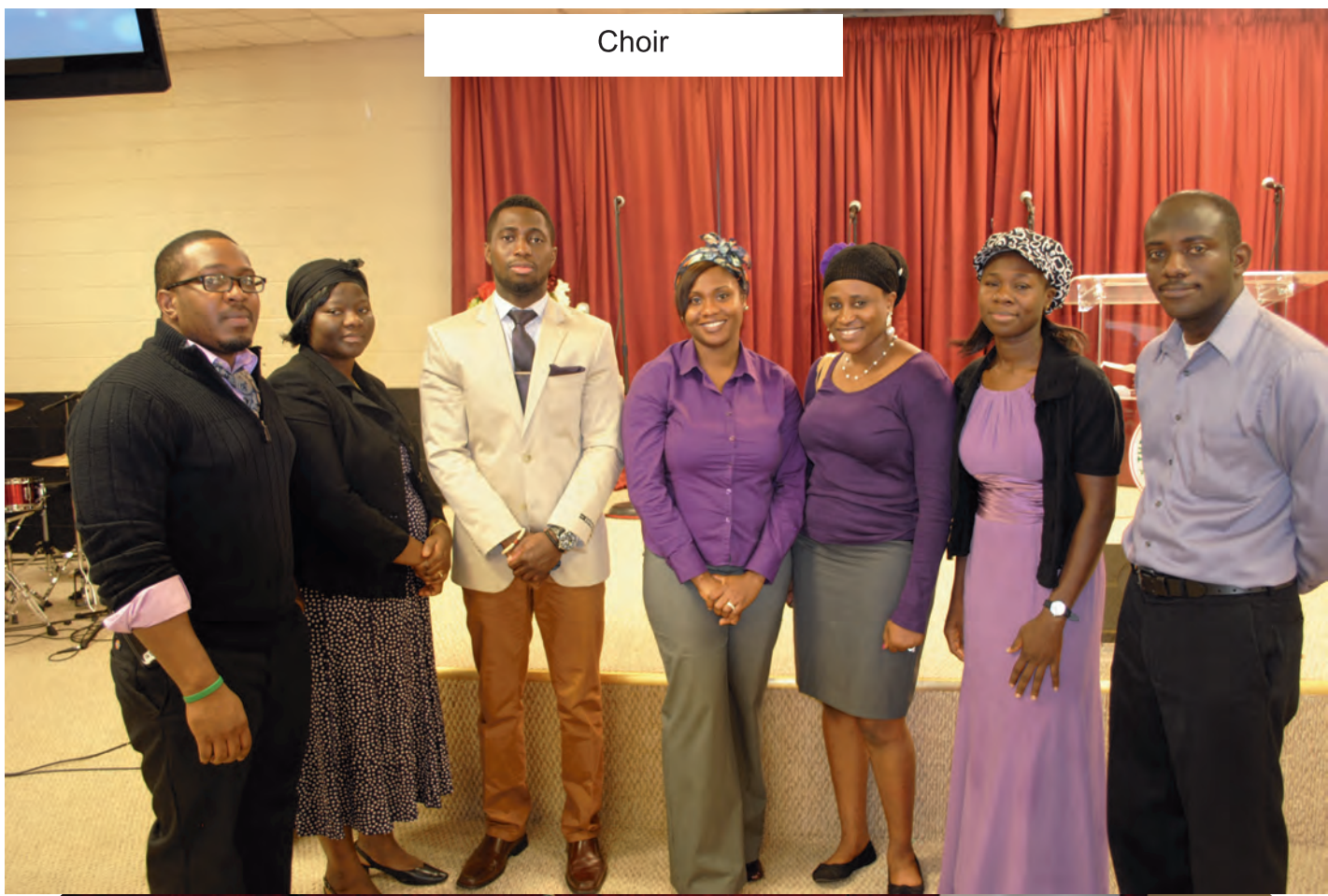

Updates on Immigration

Children who are brought to the United States (U.S.) before age 16 and do not have valid visas now have the opportunity to apply and stay in the U.S. without fear of deportation. Some of the requirements to be met include: Being enrolled in school, be a high school graduate, absence of any criminal record, and demonstrate that they have very low incomes. Applicants will qualify to apply for a work permit if they can prove that their income is insufficient for survival. The work permit is NOT issued immediately; this can last for several months to a year. This measure however, does not automatically lead to a green card being issued. This is a temporary measure put in place to delay any immediate action on the children for two years, to enable Congress make a firm decision on the program. Applicants should therefore not have the wrong impression of being issued a green card or permanent stay after they have applied for a work permit.

Another potential implication of this program is that, applicants would have their data with immigration once they apply for this benefit. This information becomes beneficial to applicants if Congress eventually approves a more permanent measure to protect them. However, should Congress terminate or disapprove of the program, such data will be available for future actions. However, this should not necessarily discourage people from applying if they qualify.

Finally, documentation is crucial in this case, to verify the validity of claims made by applicants. Evidence must be provided by applicants to show their presence in the U.S. before age 16. School records, immunization records, address confirmations, purchases made with dates, vehicle receipts, and vehicle registration, are some of the acceptable documents.
