


Children


@ 2907 Governors Drive

HE WILL DO A NEW THING

The number eight in the Bible represents a time of new beginning, the Lord saved Noah and his family (total of eight in number) in an ark to make a new beginning which signals a new era (2 Peter 2:5).

In this article, we would examine eight lessons in the life of a virtuous woman, in the 8th book of the Bible (Ruth) who experienced a new era even though she was a foreigner. God is a God of principle, it doesn't matter your position or designation, if you draw near to God, He will surely draw near unto you (James 4:8); He will begin a new thing in your life, move you from glory to glory, and your life will never remain the same.

LOVE

The greatest commandment for any serious minded child of God is to love (Matthew 22: 37-40). We are commanded to love God and love our neighbors. Ruth found herself in a precarious situation but refused to let go of the God of Israel. She decided to follow God to an unknown destination just like Abraham. This is an indication of love for God and the people of God (Ruth 1:17). How easy is it for you to demonstrate your love toward God and His people in times of tribulations or unfavorable situations? The church in Ephesus received condemnation because they abandoned their first love for God (Revelation 2:4). It is



important to ask God for the grace to love Him more and more on a daily basis with a significant reflection on the people around you. To love is not an option, but an act of obedience to God.

SELF DETERMINATION

Sometimes in the journey of life, you are surrounded by people, situations, or circumstances to discourage you and make you turn your back on God or at least slow you down in your Christian race; the choice is always yours either to yield to the devices of the enemy or not. Ruth was in a similar situation, but she encouraged herself in the Lord. Sometimes you are the only one that can encourage yourself, if you are waiting for someone else to do it for you at that point in time, you may find yourself drowning in the sea of self-pity. Discouragement can come from any angle, even from your loved ones knowingly or unknowingly (Ruth 1:18) and the goal is to throw you off balance and thereby prevent you from attaining the plan and purpose of God for your life; watch out and hold on to the right and only Pillar of life.

ENTHUSIASM

While Ruth was in the field, she served diligently to the point that she was noticed by Boaz, the field master (Ruth 2:5). Whatever you find yourself doing in your day to day activities, do it enthusiastically knowing fully well that God is the only one that can reward your labor of love. Don't wait for commendation from man so that you will not be derailed. Ruth remained focused and did not lose her reward, you also need to work relentlessly in such a way that you are not deprived of your reward.

SACRIFICIAL OFFERING:

Ruth offered herself to the God of Israel without looking back. This implies that sacrificial offering is not just in material things, your personal commitment to the things of the Lord in any way will never be in vain.

"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service." Romans 12:1 Remember that your body is the temple of God, therefore keep your vessels and your surroundings readily available for the Master's use.

HUMILITY:

Ruth humbled herself to fulfill the wish of her mother-in-law.

She had an option to follow younger men or someone from her own tribe, but she chose otherwise. Humility opens the door to exaltation. Someone that finds it difficult to humble himself may find it difficult to obey God. Ruth obeyed the mentor of her life without questioning which can sometimes be difficult, but the grace of God will always be sufficient for you as you lean upon the Rock that never fails.

FAITH:

She was a woman of faith. Her faith in God helped her to look up far above the situations and circumstances surrounding her. She moved to the next level of her life because of her trust in the God of Israel. Faith in God will help you to please God, and when your way pleases God, the enemy of your breakthrough will not have an option but to bow before you.

PRESSING ON:

Ruth demonstrated the message of Paul by putting her past behind and reaching forth unto those things which are before. She pressed on toward the mark for the prize of the high calling and she was able to attain her goal (Philippians 3:13-14). Learn from your past mistakes, focus on today, and hope for a better tomorrow through Christ that strengthens you.

MERCY OF GOD:

Ruth was definitely a beneficiary of the mercy of God (Romans 9:15-16). The mercy of God will qualify you when your strength and the strength of your helpers fail. Naomi loved her two daughters-in-law (Orpah and Ruth) who both pleaded to return with her unto the land of Judah (Ruth 1:10). However, the mercy of God qualified Ruth to become part of the earthly family through which our Savior came into the world.



In this new season, be expectant, demonstrate your love towards God and His people and never allow that love to wax cold, He will surely do a new thing in your life IJN.

I am addressing the issue of living in love and unity as Christians. I always tremble at the last part of Galatians 5:21:

"That they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God"

To think that if we live exhibiting anger, selfish ambitions, envy and the like, we will not inherit the kingdom of God makes me shudder because it is very rampant among believers. For those of us who want to make it to heaven, this is a serious thing to ponder over; let's be encouraged more than ever before as we read through this write up to let love dwell in this mortal body.

Recently in my rush not to be late for an appointment, I left the electric oven on. Since I am the last person to usually leave home in the morning, you can imagine the implications of this. About 10 minutes after leaving home, I remembered I had not taken an item I will need, so I drove back home to pick it. I could not be thankful enough that the Lord had brought me back at such a critical time. Later that same day, I asked someone to do something for me and at a time when I was expecting that service rendered he just said "Oops I forgot". I was just about to show disappointment and complain, when the Holy Spirit quickly ministered to me. "You also forgot something and I did not hold it against you. Can't you do same for your brother?" Brethren, let's forgive one another our faults just as Christ has forgiven us freely. Most of us behave like the man who was forgiven his debt in millions but immediately dragged someone who owed him a few thousands to prison. Matthew 18:21-35.

I don't know how many of us want to be blessed in our homes and ministries. Psalm 133:3b gives a recipe for receiving God's blessings. I paraphrase: For there (in the midst of brethren dwelling together in unity) the Lord bestows His blessings.

In other words, the hurting child is everyone's child and until he/she is well, we should all be burdened.

I am convinced beyond every reasonable doubt that if we live in love and harmony as a church or family in the way that the bible prescribes, the things that will be happening in our midst will just be too wonderful; and evangelism will be very easy.

I conclude with Philippians 4:8: **Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.**



PURSUE, OVERTAKE AND RECOVER ALL - David Tettey

This is one of many sermons that has blessed my heart and it is an honor to share it with us on this special occasion. Our text will largely center on 1 Samuel 30:1-8. Four main issues shall be discussed from this text. I trust that the Lord will minister unto us as we read through the body of this text.

A brief background about how David acquired Ziklag is summarized here: In 1 Sam 22:2, David became the captain of a group of people who were destitute, indebted and discontented. While escaping from the sword of Saul, David met with King Achish of Gath and requested for Ziklag which was given to him (1 Sam 27:6). David therefore made Ziklag his camp where he and his mighty men, the destitute, the distressed, the indebted and frustrated group dwelt. In 2nd Samuel 23: 8-13, the account shows that David raised up a group of mighty men who went on war expeditions with him. The city Ziklag became a secure and a comfortable place where they dwelt with their wives and kids. One day, while David and his mighty men returned from one of his many warring expeditions, they saw that Ziklag had been invaded and burnt down by the Amalekites, 1 Samuel 30:1. Bible scholars say that the Amalekites were a war-like people or cave men who loved to lick blood; they hide in the dark, come out all of a sudden and pounce on their unsuspecting victims. The sudden invasion and destruction of Ziklag by the Amalekites is akin to some challenges we face as Christians when we think we have arrived. When we are in our Ziklag, our secure place, when we think we are strong and untouchable; where our confidence is; sometimes we find the Amalekites (the enemy) invading our camp to cause a lot of havoc. In John 10:10, the bible says the thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. Jesus has however given us hope in the same verse by saying "I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly". It is clear from the passage that David and his mighty men were careless by not ensuring that they had mighty men to protect Ziklag while away. This is a lesson for us to be always watchful as believers: 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:




Furthermore, when we are faced with such unexpected misfortunes, there are usually 2 kinds of attitudes: wailing or prevailing. Wailers weep and wail, while prevailers take up arms and fight against their enemies. Wailers complain and blame everybody including God for their troubles. Prevailers prove more powerful than the force opposing them. David's men experienced the same problem – a common enemy attacked all of them and their families were taken captive; some were wailers and others were prevailers. We can look at wailing and prevailing as a natural and supernatural reaction to crisis respectively. It is ordinary to wail when you are attacked but it takes something extraordinary in the inside of us to rise up against your assailants. Our attitudes, and not the magnitude of an attack, determines our reaction to crisis – if we are strong, every attack looks small. Wailers respond negatively to trials and afflictions. David's men clearly demonstrated this negative attitude when they found out that Ziklag had been raised to the ground. Like David, let's encourage ourselves to be prevailers and not wailers when we face diverse kinds of trials.

It is interesting to note in verse 6 of the text, the determination of the people to stone David for a disaster that had befallen them all including David himself. It is surprising how we easily point accusing fingers towards our leaders anytime there is a mishap. We have to appreciate that a lot of times, our leaders may be going through much more challenging situations than we are; and the best we can do is to keep praying for them instead of pointing accusing fingers at them.

Another important lesson we can learn is found in verses 7 and 8; "7: And David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, I pray thee, bring me hither the ephod. And Abiathar brought thither the ephod to David. 8: And David enquired at the Lord, saying, Shall I pursue after this troop? Shall I overtake them? And He answered him, Pursue: for thou shalt surely overtake them, and without fail recover all.

David knew that as a priest of Israel, God will speak to him when he wears the ephod; and truly, God spoke to him when he enquired of the Lord. Is it a chronic disease? The Lord is saying, pursue, for thou shall surely overtake and without fail, recover all. We are victors in Christ; let us live accordingly as children of God.






