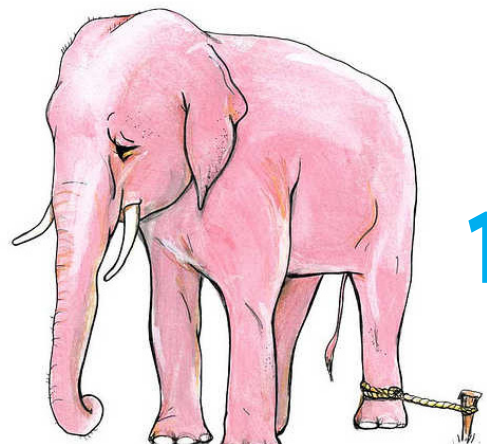

Prayer

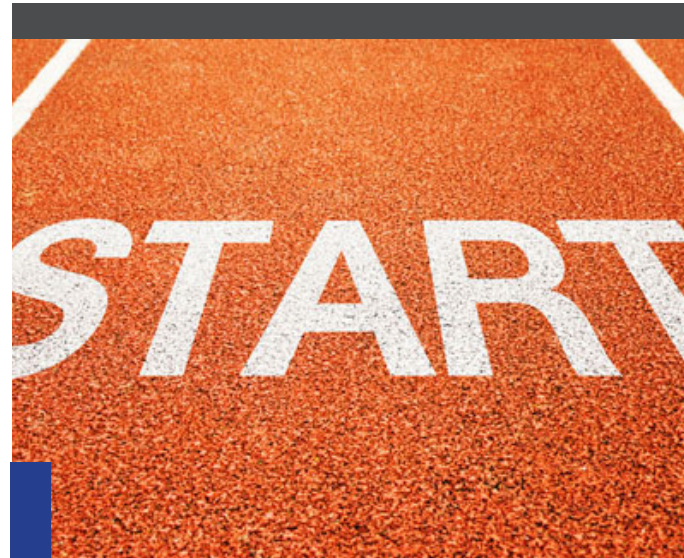

One day, Jesus, the one called Rabbi, which means great lecturer, from one of his campuses (mountain top) delivered one of his best and longest lectures to his students and the multitudes who came to his open air lecture. He said "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your father". GIFTS AND CALLING

Gifts and calling lie at the heart of every leadership vocation. In order to exercise leadership in any area of life, we must know our gifts and calling. Throughout the Bible, we see a pattern of people being called to step up into leadership roles. They are not all called in the same way. However, there is a point in the lives of people when they sense that a demand is being placed on them to step into leadership. That point is the point where they become aware that their lives must be lived for something bigger than their own personal purpose; that is what we call a 'calling'. Everyone has a calling in one way or the other.

Text: Romans 12:6-7 and 1 Peter 4:10-11

Although the above passages speak about spiritual gifts and how to use them, the principles there apply to our natural gifts and how to use them as well. The few thoughts we can bring out are that:

1. Our gifts are not the same. No two gifts are exactly the same because every gift is personalized.
2. Our gifts show God's ability in us. It is a sign of God's Grace in us.
3. Our gifts require good stewardship. We have to properly use the gifts God has given us. If we use our gifts well, they will function well for us and the reverse applies.
4. Our gifts should be our area of operation. Our gift should be the basis of what we do. For example, if we have a gift in singing, we should not go and teach. We can however, have multiple gifts and hence operate in multiple areas.

WHAT CONSTITUTES A GIFT? There are four areas we can look at to know what our gift is. These are:

1. Talent: this is what you can do naturally without a lot of effort. It is the way you are wired. It could be the ability to easily tell a story or dance.
2. Passion: this is what you really love doing. It can be likened to fire in the belly. Without passion, talent will die. Talent is like the body of a car and passion is like the engine in the car. Those with talents without an accompanying passion do not go far.
3. Experience: this is when you apply talent and passion in real life situations. Like we all know, experience is a great teacher. It helps to perfect your talent.
4. Training: this is what you learn to do (either formal or informal). About 80% of the time, the formal training we get is not directly related to our talents and passion. Overtime however, we are able to find a way to converge our training, talent and passion. Don't throw away your training because it will definitely fuel your talent one day.

When we mix the above four things, we can tell what our gift is. A gift is God's investment in your life. Our calling is our investment into people's lives. In other words, a gift is what God has given us and a calling is what we are giving to the world. Our calling makes us a blessing to the world.

There are 3 ways we can look at calling.

1. There is a General Call for everyone to be born again. It is a call to all humanity to receive Jesus as our Lord and personal savior.
2. There is also a Christian Call to be like Christ.
3. There is a Vocational Call which is the calling to work for Christ.

In this article we shall briefly address Vocational Calling. There are two kinds of Vocational Call, the sacred call (for Pastors, Missionaries, Evangelists etc.) and the circular call (to all other areas of life). Both calls are equally valuable when done to glorify God.

HOW DO WE RECEIVE A CALL? All callings don't come the same way. Let's examine these six individuals from the Bible to ascertain that.

1. Moses, he was called through a sovereign revelation from God Exodus 3:6-10.
2. David: he received a prophetic revelation 1 Sam 16:1. David's call came through Samuel.
3. Joseph: he received a private revelation in a dream Gen 37:5-7.
4. Elisha: he received his calling from his mentor, Elijah 1 Kings 19:15-16, 19
5. Nehemiah: he received a personal burden, Nehemiah 1:1-4
6. Esther: she received a public demand from the people Esther 4:13-14

What do we do to a call? Every call is there to meet a need and will impose responsibility on you. Respond to it. I pray that your life will not be ordinary as you step into greatness to fulfill your destiny.

God qualified her to be a queen and made a way for her to present her matter before king Ahasuerus. No matter your position, situation, or circumstances God can use you for great and mighty things even beyond your own imagination. Remember that God specializes in using the weak things of the world to shame the wise.

2 Allow yourself to be mentored: Since nobody knows it all, allow yourself to be groomed, nurtured, and trained by men and women whom God has placed over you. Also, be prepared to be a mentor to other women in such a way that it will bring glory to God. Mentoring has nothing to do with age or position, therefore humble yourself before God and man in your day to day activities. Queen Esther was teachable and obedient which helped her on the way to greatness.

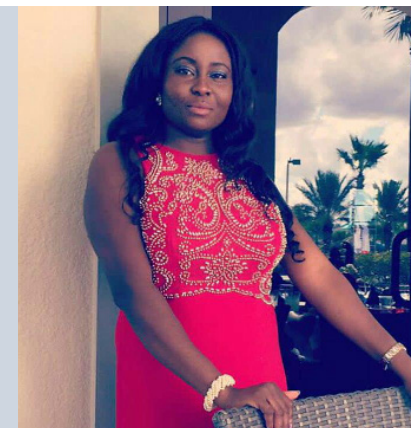
3 Embrace wisdom: It takes wisdom to seek and love God. Esther loved God and the people of God that she did not care about her own life. It is not just enough to make plans in life, you need to apply godly wisdom to all your plans. To gain wisdom requires constant fellowship with the Lord through His word and committing everything about you into His able hands. "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path." Psalm 119:105 (KJV).

4 Keep watch over your mouth: Some people have entered troubles because they did not learn how to keep their mouth under control. Queen Esther obeyed instruction not to reveal her identity which possibly could have been used against her. "Set a watch, O Lord, before my mouth; keep the door of my lips." Psalm 141:3 (KJV). Understanding the power of the tongue will help you to ask God to guard your mouth.

5 Let prayer be your lifestyle: The Bible encourages us to pray without ceasing. Mothers are the powerhouse in the home not by their own strength but by drawing strength from God through prayer and fasting. This role is very vital that husbands are commanded to give honor to their wives so that their prayers will not be hindered. A woman that understands her role will protect, uphold, defend her family through prayer. When queen Esther was confronted with a dilemma between life and death, she prayed and fasted for three days along with her brethren asking God for divine intervention.

6 Practice hospitality: Just like the Shunamite woman that used her ministry of hospitality to unlock her miracle (2 kings 4: 8 -13), Esther also applied the same principle that instead of accepting the offer from king Ahasuerus even up to half of his kingdom, she chose to invite the king and her enemy for banquet. Our father in the Lord daddy G.O. gave his first car and his first house to the Lord; today he is still reaping the benefit of giving. "Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap" Galatians 6:7 (KJV).

7 Let your light shine: Recognize and embrace your area of calling. Let your light shine through the gift of God that is within you. Queen Esther allowed her light to shine by making herself available for the children of God. She was positioned in the palace for a purpose and did not allow that opportunity to be lost.

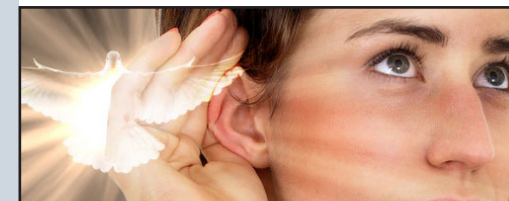

Isaiah 61: 1-3, Romans 8:14

It is common knowledge that we only live once. But the question is, "What are you doing to maximize the purpose of that thing". When a man is involved in a thought, utterance, or action that is not in line with the spirit of God, definitely the spirit other than God's spirit is in play.

Ask yourself this question, "Which spirit is leading me?" When you are in the church and out of the church, you need to ask yourself, "What spirit is leading me?"

If you engage in fights, and fraudulent activities, you need to ask yourself, "What spirit is leading me?" Romans 8:14. Agree to be led by the spirit of God. This means:

- You are born again and you have accepted the Lord as your Saviour.
- Your thoughts rub minds with the mind of God: When you think a thought contrary to the will of God, then the spirit of God has taken the back seat in your life. Live through the divine syllabus of God. Phillipians 4:8. Momentary thoughts can flash through, but because of the divine syllabus it does not take root in your life.
- Your speech is seasoned with grace. Psalm 84:11. If something doesn't edify God, then you are to take actions appropriately.
- The person's actions are spirit inspired,

kingdom expanding and love motivated: Any action that is outside these three is not led by the spirit. Acts 6: 2-3. If you are not led by the spirit, you merely are in the church, but not of the church.

Effects of not being led by the Spirit:

- You are totally disconnected from God: You don't have access to spiritual insights. Any fellow who doesn't have access to spiritual information will be alone. 1 Cor 3: 3-4. This is why you see people eating regularly in their dreams.
- If you are not led by the Holy Spirit, then you are led by the spirit of the world: you become physically inclined and carnally motivated. Romans 8:9. Carnality is the attribute of one that is not spiritually connected with God. The person will be a regular tool of the devil.

Matthew 16:23 explains this- The devil wanted to use Peter to derail Jesus from saving the world. From day one, Jesus was led by the Spirit. Luke 3: 21-23. That you are led by the Spirit does not exempt you from temptation; it however guarantees your victory over temptation.

Without being led by the Spirit, you are unable to maximize this one life that you have. Galatians 1:16. Paul said to the Corinthians that flesh and blood will not inherit the kingdom of God. Don't give room to the flesh to maximize; don't let the flesh block your eternal life.

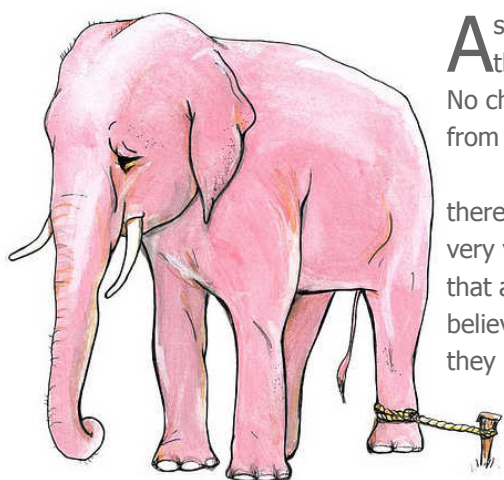
In the text above, Peter knew it was God speaking to him through the revelation but he felt he was of a higher standard than what God was asking him to do. Many things that could have been Peter's got lost because of his refusal to do what God told him.

According to the Bible, Peter fell into

trance. However, many do not have revelations from God because they do not have a relationship with him. Eternal limitations have minimum or no effect on anyone who has conquered self-imposed limitations; self-limitations are more difficult to remove than eternal limitations. Many are limiting themselves and they do not know. God cannot be limited or stranded. When Peter did not cooperate with God, he was substituted. No one is indispensable. If you say No to God, He would look for another person that would say yes. Many are suffering today because they said no to God's choice for them.

Many also are tied down with limitations rooted in ethnicity. They do not do business with or employ people from other tribes. God is the God of all flesh: Jer. 32:27. Some parents impose wills contrary to God's will on their children, thereby limiting those children.

God is not delivering breakthroughs to many because of the idols they worship, instead of God. Self-imposed limitations deny people access to great possibilities. When you get rid of self-imposed limitations, you begin to make remarkable progress in life.

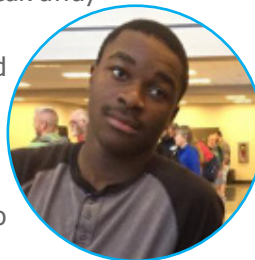
